## English Language Arts Reading

### Fluency

- Reads grade level text with fluency

### Comprehension

Retells the beginning, middle and end of stories

- Uses comprehension strategies to monitor reading

### Phonemic Awareness and Phonetics

Uses phonetic strategies to decode words

### Vocabulary

Reads grade level high frequency words

## English Language Arts Writing

### Ideas

- Writing has beginning, middle, and end
- Writes for a variety of purposes  
Expresses thoughts and ideas verbally and in writing

### Organization

- Includes a clear beginning, middle, and end

### Grammar and Mechanics

- Uses ending punctuation
- Uses simple sentences

### Spelling

- Spells high frequency grade level words correctly
- Uses phonetic spelling with unfamiliar words

## Handwriting

- Writes legibly with correct spacing
- Writes numbers, capital and lowercase letters correctly and consistently
- Writes numbers, words, and sentences with appropriate spacing and use of baseline

## Mathematics

### Number and Numeration

- Reads, writes, counts numbers to 1000
- Counts by 1s, 2s, 5s, & 10s

### Operations and Computation

- Demonstrates proficiency with + and – zero, and doubles (4+4)
- Demonstrates proficiency with addition and subtraction facts to 10

### Data and Chance

- Collects, organizes, and uses data to create charts, tables, graphs, and line plots

### Measurement and Reference Frames

- Measures with inches and cm
- Tells and shows time to the nearest half and quarter hour

### Patterns, Functions, and Algebra

- Extends, describes, and creates patterns

### Money

Knows and compares value of pennies, nickels, dimes, quarters and dollar bills

## Science

### Trees ; Force and Motion

- Makes accurate observations
- Uses appropriate tools and units of measure
- Asks appropriate questions
- Uses results to make predictions
